

WHAT QUALIFIES ME FOR DENTAL CARE?

- You must be 18 years of age or older
- Have a photo ID or passport
- Please provide a current copy of your food stamp award letter in order to qualify you to receive dental care
- You must be low-income and follow the household size guidelines and proof of income

If you don't qualify for food stamps, you will need to provide copies of all income documents for ALL person's living in the same house. If your household size agrees with our guidelines of your gross income, you will be eligible to receive dental care.

PLEASE PROVIDE ALL THAT APPLIES TO YOU:

- Paycheck Stubs/Employer statement showing gross income (for recent 2 months with dates)
- DSHS Award Letter (TANF, Food stamps, Disability Lifeline (formerly GAU/GAX))
- Child Support/Adoption or Foster Care Support
- Social Security /SSI/Survivor Benefit Award Letter
- Pensions/Annuity/IRA, Interests & Dividends
- Labor and Industry (L&I) Statement Military benefits
- Self-Employed (Most recent FULL tax return and 3 month profit & loss statements)
- ESD (unemployment)
